

Harrinson Memorial

Erected 1887 and made of Portland stone the memorial is located in St Mary's churchyard adjacent to St Mary Butts.

The architect was Spencer Slingsby Stallwood.

It records the many benefactions of Isaac Harrinson who spent a lot of his money clearing the slums in Reading and particularly those in St Mary Butts.

He died several years after the memorial was erected.
