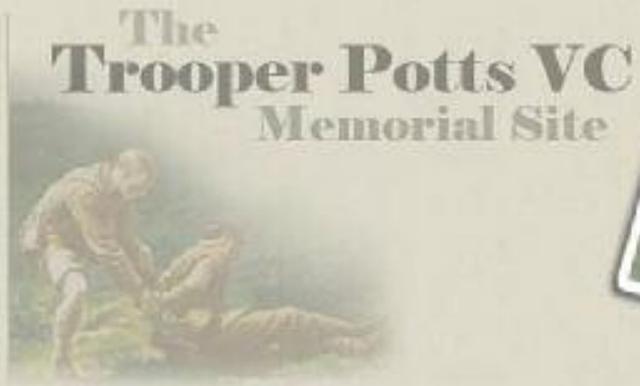

## *St Anne's Hall*

St Anne's Hall in Caversham had 23 beds. It opened 13th May 1915 and closed 31st May 1919. It was operated by the Red Cross as Berks 60. It was the private home of Mrs Crawshaw OBE who not only made it freely available to the Red Cross and paid all the expenses. She acted as Commandant.

It treated 772 patients.
